

NCEA Level 1 Computing US Course

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course provides students with an introduction to Computing at a Senior Level. Students will study a selection of Unit Standard Computer skills workbooks. Subject to teacher evaluation in Term 1, students may be encouraged to transfer to the Achievement Standard Course which is run at the same time.
