NCEA Level 1 Digital Technology AS Course

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course provides students with an introduction to Digital Technology at a Senior Level. Students will study a selection of concepts and skills in a design team structure with a focus on Digital media, Web Design or another digital outcome. Students will produce a portfolio of work incorporating four internal assessments for a maximum of 16 Internal Achievement Standard credits. They also have the opportunity to develop their design and outcome incorporating other areas from the Technology or Science Curriculum areas with the permission of relevant teachers.

PREREQUISITE

None- but successful completion of the Year 10 Digital Technology programme would be helpful.
