Enrolment Scheme Policy

PURPOSE

The school has an approved enrolment scheme which came into effect on 24 April 2023. The board accepts that it has a responsibility to implement and operate the scheme to ensure:

- Students living in zone have an automatic preferential right to entry.
- To avoid overcrowding or the likelihood of overcrowding at the school.
- That the selection of applicants for enrolment at the school is carried out in a fair and transparent manner.
- Compliance is maintained as per section 71 to 75 and Schedule 20 of the Education and Training Act 2020.

GUIDELINES

- 1. The enrolment scheme is published for student and parent information on our website.
- 2. The Principal is responsible for establishing a set of procedures to effectively manage the enrolment scheme within the guidelines produced by the Ministry of Education.
- 3. The Principal is responsible for the enrolment process, but may delegate this responsibility to a Senior Leadership Team member/Staff Committee, which includes:
 - a. Review and development of enrolment forms.
 - b. Information dissemination and/or meetings for students and their parents.
 - c. Organisation of enrolment times.
 - d. Procedures for checking authenticity of addresses and living arrangements of applicants.
 - e. Reporting to the Board on enrolment information.
- 4. The Board will approve the number of out of zone places (if any) that are available.
- 5. Out of zone enrolment procedures will comply with Ministry of Education requirements.
